

04. MYTH VS. REALITY

What do Landscape Architects Actually Do?

A landscape architects' role is a lot larger than most people realize. When a landscape architect managers your project, they ensure that every part of the exterior build processis handled to ensure that the biggest investment in your life is safe and secure.

Myth	Reality
Landscape architects are landscapers.	Landscape architects work with landscapers, along with many other professionals (architects, engineers, interior designers, etc.), but do not execute the physical work that a landscaper would.
Anyone can call themselves a landscape architect.	To become a landscape architect, one must first attend a college or university that has an accredited landscape architecture program. Upon graduation, one must complete an apprenticeship program for a required number of years (every state outlines their own time frame). During this time, a prospective landscape architect must complete the required board exams and complete the required continuing education programs on a yearly basis.
A landscape architect only designs with plants.	A landscape architects role encompasses everything on the outside of home, plants are just one part.
You should contact a landscape architect once your home is built.	To achieve the best results for your outdoor spaces, it's crucial to engage a landscape architect from the start of your project. Many people mistakenly hire a pool builder or other contractors first, leading to suboptimal designs and costly revisions. By consulting with us at the outset, we can develop a comprehensive plan that considers the ideal placement of many key project features ensuring a harmonious and functional outdoor environment.

When hiring an landscape architect, it's helpful to have a process to make sure you get the best person for the project.

Although extensive schooling and training are required for all landscape architects, that doesn't mean all architects are created equal. Do you offer a pre-design analysis service to help move us safely and efficiently towards the design process?	Do you have a team game plan that outlines how we will all successfully work together, even under pressure?
What are the specific challenges for our type of project and how have you overcome these in the past?	Will you run the bid/tender process to find and select the best construction team?
If my budget, timeline and scope of project are unrealistic, will you let me know?	What educational material do you provide so we can understand the requirements of our specific type of project?

How do you want to feel as you move through your new exterior spaces?	
Who are the important people this home needs to be designed for?	
What are the budget, timeframes and boundaries we need to work within?

07. READINESS ASSESSMENT

Are you ready to Move To The Design Phase?

This exercise allows you to assess how ready you are to move to the Design Phase. If you are not close to 10 on ALL scales, then it's best to seek help from an expert to complete this research. If you rush into the design phase without this information available, you'll run the risk of making too many assumptions, which is the #1 reason projects go over budget and over time.
