The Major Steps Required for Designing and Building Your New Home Extension



### The Big Burning Question that Everyone Wants to Know

The most dreaded question architects, builders and every other professional hates has got to be, 'how much will my project cost'? There are so many variables that a definitive answer is literally impossible. Even worse, the consequences of trying to answer and risk giving 'bad advice' will have most experts running away to avoid the question. The problem is that this question is VERY important. No one can proceed if they don't have a ball-park estimation of cost. This guide will help you to determine an estimate of overall project costs. Your actual number may be more or less, but it can be helpful to see an estimated figure. These figures are based on a national average, are ground floor rear extensions to the plaster finish stage and exclude VAT.

Extension Quality	Size	Price Range - Low	Price Range - High	Price Range - Average
Basic Extension	20 sqm	£40,000	£56,000	£48,000
Medium Extension	30 sqm	£60,000	£84,000	£72,000
Premium Extension	30 sqm	£75,000	£110,000	£92,500
Large Extension	50 sqm	£100,000	£140,000	£120,000

#### Factors that will affect the cost of your extension:

- Type of extensions Basement, side or double storey extensions will all cost more than a single rear extension
- Build quality particularly in regard to windows, doors, insulation, soundproofing
- Accessibility access issues for large machinery to get to where the build needs to happen, will create higher labour costs and will affect the timeline
- More unusual designs such as vaulted ceilings will require more steelwork and will require more drawings from certain professionals such as a structural engineer
- Regionality labour costs are higher in the south and in London than elsewhere
- The interior design as well as the added features of kitchens, bathrooms, joinery and other bespoke features
- Getting the right professionals the cheapest cannot be the best, they just cut corners. Go for the best value, who will be paid well but will deliver the best outcome.
- And finally getting the design right from the beginning. Changing a design after it has started could greatly affect the budget and will cause delays.


