



- **Time and Consultations:** Time spent in meetings with clients, officials, and builders also contributes to the final cost.

Feasibility Study:



ARE DEFINETLY THE MOST COMPLEX AND SIGNIFICANT COSTS IN A PROJECT. HERE ARE SOME OF THE MOST COMMONLY NEEDED IN ANY JOB:

Demolition and Site

Preparation: Initial steps that set the stage for construction; costs vary with project size and complexity.

Construction Labor: Wages for carpenters, laborers, and tradespeople.

Construction Materials: Costs for lumber, concrete, insulation, and other supplies.



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


